On behalf of the Woodville/Wilkinson County Main Street Association, we invite you to exhibit and to sell your work at our annual **Art Under The Oaks** in historic downtown Woodville, Mississippi. **Art Under The Oaks** will be held in conjunction with the Woodville Deer & Wildlife Festival, a celebration of the arts and culture of the region, and 2009 winner of Mississippi Main Street's highest honor, "Best Special Event", among the 53 Main Street communities in the state.

Participation in the juried **Art Under The Oaks** is limited to craft artists, painters, printmakers and photographers, both film and digital. The entry fee is \$25 and entitles you to a 10X10 exhibit space.

Your work will be eligible for inclusion in our "Highlights of **Art Under The Oaks**" Exhibition, a spotlight show of selected works displayed during the Arts event in a gallery space on the square. The spotlight show may be extended beyond the close of the **Art Under The Oaks**, in which case your work will, with your permission, remain on exhibit for a limited period of time. All sales proceeds will remain entirely yours; no other fees or contributions will be expected of you.

The Association will make cash awards of \$300 to the artist whose work is judged "Best of Show", \$200 for "First Honor", and \$150 for "Second Honor". In addition, four Honorable Mention Awards will be given in the following categories: "Best Booth Display", "Most Unique Work", and "Most Authentic Traditional Work" (2 winners).

You may accept this invitation on or before **August 15, 2011**, by signing, dating, and returning a copy of this letter in the enclosed envelope, along with the **information requested**. We will follow up with a request for more detailed information on your work, if we need it.
